
He has a vast experi-

CCC-2017 Report

The International Society of Manual Small Incision Cataract Surgeons (ISMSICS) jointly with Aravind Eye Hospital, organized the 2nd World Conference on MSICS at ITC Grand Chola, Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India. The event was held on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd of December 2017. The pre-conference workshop was held on 1st of Dec, 2017 at newly inaugurated Aravind Eye Hospital, Chennai. The dedicated Aravind team left no stone unturned in making excellent arrangements. Pre conference symposia were followed by live surgical demonstration by Phaco and SICS masters. The main conference was held on the 2nd and 3rd of Dec, 2017 at ITC Grand Chola.

The 2nd World Conference of MSICS had the whole gamut of cataract surgery from patient selection, preoperative preparation, instrumentation, various surgical techniques, postoperative care and ways & means to manage surgical complications. Expert cataract surgeons from across the globe shared their experiences. Some of the

key note addresses on SICS were delivered by masters in Phacoemulsification. The conference was full of multiple, simple home messages take which could be implemented in day to day practice from the next day onwards. This was the largest benefit of CCC-2017, was the feeling voiced by many delegates.
